LARC Dalayday project soars on World Water Day

To celebrate World Water Day last March 22, 2017, Laguna Water District Aquatech Resources Corporation (LARC) lined up several activities for its service areas. Community welcomes Vega pump upgrade

As part of Laguna Water District Aquatech Resources Corporation's (LARC's) commitment to improve its facilities, the company recently completed the upgrade of its Vega Pump station located at Brgy. Batong Malake, Los Baños, Laguna.

The upgrade consisted of replacing old water pump and motor to new ones with bigger water capacity. Water supply was briefly interrupted in the affected areas during installation that started at 8:00 in the evening of January 12, 2017 and was completed at 5:00 in the morning the next day.

The Vega pump station serving parts of Batong Malake, San Antonio, Mayondon, and Bayog provides delivery of water to around 7,400 concessionaires. The growing water demand in the areas affected the pump station's capacity to discharge water, particularly during peak hours. Hence, several households experienced low water to no water during the hours when water demand was high. The recent upgrade of the Vega pump station increased its water capacity discharge and is currently able to meet the demand needed. In addition, the pump station's water pressure is now maintained at a minimum of 10 pounds per square inch. The increased water production of the Vega pump station can accommodate additional service connections within its influence areas.

Zone Specialists wagi sa mga barangay

Nagtagala ng mga zone specialists ang Laguna Water District Aquatech Resources Corporation (LARC) upang mas mailapit ang kanilang serbisyo sa kanilang mga kunsesyunaro. Ang mga zone specialists ay regular na bumibisita sa mga barangay halls na nasasakupan ng kanilang serbisyo simula noong Enero 2017.

Ang LARC zone specialist ay naglalaan ng dalawang oras sa bawat isang barangay na kanyang binibisita. Madaling makikilala ang LARC zone specialist sa kanyang LARC na uniporme at suot na LARC I.D.

Dahil sa mas madalas nang nakakapunta ang LARC sa bawat barangay, maari nang ipagbigay alam ng mga konsesyonaryo ang kanilang mga suliranin o pangangailangan na may kinalaman sa serbisyo ng LARC sa tanggapan ng barangay para mabisita ng zone specialist ang residente o lugar ng konsesyonaryong may problema o katanungan tungkol sa serbisyo ng tubig.

Dalayday was launched last March 18, 2017 during Linis Ilat, the first ever multi-sectoral clean-up of Laguna Lake tributaries in Los Baños, Laguna. Linis Ilat is an initiative of LARC and Laguna Water District (LWD) together with Los Baños Group (LBG) and Junior Chamber International-Los Baños (JCI-LB). The activity was spearheaded by Hon. Caesar P. Perez, Mayor of Los Baños, who is an influential advocator on solid waste management. Around 1,000 volunteers participated in the clean-up including residents and Sangguniang Barangays of Anos, Bambang, Batong Malake, Baybayin, Bayog, Lalakay, Maahas, Malinta, Mayondon, Putho-Tuntungin, San Antonio, Tadlac, and Timugan. The Bureau of Fire Protection- Los Baños, Los Baños Army, Philippine National Police-Los Baños, and Fisheries Aquatic Resources Management Council- Los Baños (FARMC-Los Baños) also showed their support by participating in the activity that started from 6:00 am. LARC and LWD together with Mayor Perez and other organizations plan to make this a yearly event.

Online photo-slogan contest

Aside from the Linis Ilat LARC also conducted Waterways: *A healthy lake makes a healthy life*, an online photo-slogan contest that was launched on February 14, 2017 and ended last March 28, 2017 about Laguna Lake rehabilitation.
